CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

The curriculum and instruction are in accordance with the requirements of the state of Wisconsin and the WELS. Curriculum guides are available to learn more about the scope and objectives in each subject. ORLS's curriculum is aligned with the truths of God's Word. Teachers use a variety of instructional strategies and approaches to reach their students' varied interests and abilities. Teaching strategies like direct instruction, cooperative learning, project-based learning, summarizing, note-taking, and nonlinguistic representations are utilized. A variety of tools accompany instruction from textbooks to Chromebooks, manipulatives, songs, movement, and learning applications.

ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT

ORLS takes pride in equipping students for the next level of their education and life. Students are well prepared for high school after their time at Our Redeemer. Standardized testing is used to validate the effectiveness of our curriculum and instruction.

MULTI-AGE CLASSROOMS

Multi-age classrooms provide a rich classroom experience. Older students develop leadership and mentoring skills while collaborating with younger students. Relationships are fostered over two years with the classroom teacher. Varied groupings can be utilized across grade levels. Multi-age classrooms mirror student interactions in the real world. The curriculum design supports multi-age learning environments. Classrooms adopt a family-feel as students alternate being the oldest students in the room, to the youngest the next year.
